
Explore Your Computer

Windows is your computer's brain! From Windows 95 to Windows 11, each version brought new powers. Windows 10 is still the classroom hero!




Quick Access

- Use the search box on the taskbar to find programs
- Quick Launch toolbar gives access to frequently used apps and files



Task Manager


- Monitor running apps and system performance
- Use it to close frozen apps
- Access it via Ctrl+Shift+Esc or search 'Task Manager'



Task View & Virtual Desktops

- Use Task View to manage multiple desktops
- Switch with Alt+Tab or Windows Key + Tab
- · Move apps between desktops and stays organized

Select and End task for apps using the most space




Troubleshooting


- Restart your computer
- Check cables and connections

- Update software
- Run troubleshooters

- Scan for malware
- Free up disk space







Fix-It Toolkit

- Use Task Manager to monitor performance.
- Go to Settings > Update & Security > Troubleshoot.
 - Use Windows Defender to scan for malware
